This course approaches the practical problems that face the diagnostic pathologist when dealing with cardiovascular pathology which is the most common cause of death in the western world today. The approach to the cardiac autopsy, cardiac anatomy and cardiac dissection will be emphasised. Topics covered include: sudden cardiac death, valvular heart disease, paediatric heart disease, cardiomyopathies, inherited cardiac disease, myocarditis and post-operative deaths. A large collection of cardiac specimens are also included for study during this two day intensive course.
