Guidelines for preparation and submission of abstracts

Submission deadline for abstracts: 30 April 2023 at 20:00 CET

Notification for abstracts and travel grant applications: Mid-June 2023

The Scientific Committee invites you to participate actively in this congress which will be an extraordinary occasion for the exchange of thoughts and experiences. We look forward to receiving abstracts online for consideration and inclusion in the scientific program.

All accepted abstracts will be published in an abstract book.

The reviewers will judge the abstracts according to the relevance to AECVP, originality of work and overall impression.

Please note that abstracts can only be presented (and thus published) on-site, not virtually! Please ensure that you are able to travel to Padua when submitting an abstract.

Specific guidelines for preparation and submission:

- Abstracts are to be submitted in English. Please make sure to use proper English language.
- Please avoid abbreviations in the title (exception: scientific terms). Abbreviations may be used in the text if they are defined when used first.
- Degrees, titles, street addresses and acknowledgements of support should be omitted.
- Tables, graphs and figures may not be added to your abstract.
- Submissions on behalf of other authors cannot be accepted. The original author should submit her/his work and is considered to present it on-site in Padua.
- An abstract which has been previously published cannot be submitted, unless there are new methods, findings, updated data or other acceptable reasons for submitting.
- Title should not exceed 100 characters (including spaces)
- Abstracts should be structured in the following specified subtitles (for original research only): background and aim, methods, results and conclusion. Please stick to the indicated maximum number of characters (2500 including spaces).
- Should the presenter turn out to be unable to present her / his poster or have more than two presentations on one day, one of the co-authors should take over this responsibility. A change of the presenting author needs to be communicated to giulia.damati@uniroma1.it
- Notification of acceptance or rejection by the Scientific Committee will be emailed to the submitting author. Detailed information in which format the abstract is accepted (oral or poster presentation) as well as guidelines and recommendations for each abstract type will be sent shortly after notifications to registered submitting authors.
